Day 1: 2 Peter 1:12-13

- What word or phrase jumps out to you? Why?
- How well do you know the basic truths of the Bible?
- Are you reading the Bible on a regular basis? If not, then why not?

Day 2: 2 Peter 1:14-15

- How does this passage speak to you?
- What would you do if you knew your death was coming soon?
- Where do you think you will go after death?

Day 3: 2 Peter 16

- What insight do you gain from this text?
- Why do people invent stories to explain what they do not understand? How does the Bible differ from stories that people invent?
- Imagine what it would've been like to witness Jesus' earthly life. If you could choose one event from the life of Jesus to witness, which would it be? Why?

Day 4: 2 Peter 17-18

- What's one question you have about this passage?
- Would you be frightened or joyful if you heard God's voice? Why?
- What does it mean to say that Jesus is the Son of God? How would you explain this to someone else?

Day 5: 2 Peter 19

- What can you learn from this text?

- Are you paying attention to the words of the prophets during dark times in your life?
- How excited are you for the day of the rising of the Morning Star when Jesus comes again? Why or why not?

Day 6: 2 Peter 20-21

- What's God saying to you through these verses?
- What does Peter say about the prophet's interpretation of Scripture?
- Who was side by side with the prophets as they wrote? Why is this important?

Day 7: 2 Peter 12-21

Read through the entire passage. Write down the **one verse** that spoke to you the most this week. Commit the verse to memory for an extra challenge!
